

Bin 88

GI: Barossa Valley Variety: 100% Shiraz

From one of the world's most iconic region's for Shiraz, Barossa – South Australia. Bin 88 Shiraz has all the hallmarks of this acclaimed region.

Picked in the early hours of the morning, the grapes were delivered to the winery and crushed to stainless steel tanks.

Plunged by hand, the grapes were fermented in small open top tanks. Pressed to barrel, the wine was allowed to undergo malolactic transition in French oak casks. The wine barrel down to seasoned French oak barrels for 8 months of maturation.

Inky with a deep red hue, this wine has alluring aromas of cigar box and chocolate that are underpinned by fresh dark berries. These fruit notes come to the forefront on the palate with brooding Black Forrest fruits and notes of black tea. The wine coats the palate and lingers in a long velvety finish.

This wine has been crafted to be bold and vibrant in its youth, but will age gracefully over the next 5 years.



Bin 88 Shiraz Cabernet

GI: Clare Valley

Variety: Shiraz 52%, Cabernet Sauvignon 48%

The Shiraz Cabernet blend has long been embraced by Australia and has quickly become in quintessential icon. Crafted in the cool climate of South Australia's Clare Valley, the fruit was taken from some of Kilikanoon's most southern vineyards. These sites were chosen as to finely balance the powerful flavours with the rich layers and structure of the classic blend.

Harvested in mid-March, the grapes were delivered to the winery and crushed to open top stainless-steel tanks. Allowed to start fermentation naturally, the wine was plunged and worked by hand to carefully extract the flavours. The wine was then matured for 9 months in proven French puncheons.

Deep Red in colour with a purple hue, the wine has rich aromas of dark berries with savoury undertones. This transitions seamlessly to the palate with bright cassis flavours. The palate is enveloping and soft with a long powdery tannin.

A classic blend that has received multiple gold medals since premier vintage.



Bin 88 Reserve

GI: Clare Valley

Variety: 100% Shiraz

Harvested solely from the Estate vineyard of Kilikanoon – an icon of elegant Australian Shiraz, this wine has quickly become a benchmark for cool climate shiraz. This wine has been crafted to show the fine balance of cool climate elegancy, bracing a soft yet complex structure with the intensity of rich fruits.

With the vineyards ringing the winery, the fruit was picked at the perfect time with the fruit showing ripe flavours and retaining its natural acidity. The fruit was crushed to small batch open top tanks where it was slowly fermented to retain the fine flavours and aromas. Pressed in traditional basket presses, the light pressings were separated, leaving the firmer tannins behind. This wine was then matured in a combination of new and seasoned French barrels.

Deep red with the colour going all the way to the hue, rich varietal aromas of savoury earth tones are underpinned by blueberry notes. The varietal expression is continued on the luscious and generous palate with flavours of ripe red cherries and linger light spices of clove and cinnamon. The flavours that drive this wine linger long on the finish.

This finely balanced wine is a classic example of the elegance of cool climate Clare Shiraz. While delectable and enveloping young, this wine will soften and show its true nature over the next 8 years.

Bin 88 Grand Reserve

GI: Clare Valley

Variety: 100% Shiraz

Patience is a virtue, and with wine highly rewarding. This is certainly true of the Bin88 Grand Reserve. Endearing trust and tradition, the grapes for this wine were harvested form a single vineyard that was planted over 160 years ago. This multi-generational commitment now allows us to produce a truly spectacular wine, that is truly reflective of the Clare Valley. Hand picked at first light, the fruit was brought to the winery and loaded into a small traditional vat. The bunches were lightly pressed to split the grapes without maceration. Allowed to start fermenting naturally, the gapes were hand plunged 3 times day for 14 days. After fermentation, the vat was poured into a traditional basket press and allowed to drain. The grapes were then lightly pressed with only the finest cut being separated off. Allowed to undergo malolactic in a selected combination of French oak, the wine was left on its malo lees for 9 months.

Dark and rich in colour, the complexing layered aromas slowly lift from the glass giving floral, dark berries and dried herbal notes. This rich aroma is mimicked on the palate with a range of flavours of blackcurrant, black tea and olive tapenade.

The intensity and complex flavours of this wine stem from the small berries that were taken from vines of such age. This wine has naturally developed this intensity and while stunning now, will develop gracefully over the next 15 years.
